## Your Honor:

Please accept this letter requesting a Court Order directing production of certain items from the Morris County Prosecutor's investigative file, specifically forensic data extractions from the cell phones of Lauren Kanarek, Michael Barisone and Robert Goodwin, pursuant to a subpoena duces tecum from a party to the above-captioned matter, Sweet Grass Farms, LLC ("SGF").

In May 2022, after the trial of the parallel criminal matter, State v. Michael Barisone, Indictment No. 19-12-999-I, the Morris County Prosecutor's Office ("MCPO") produced over 30,000 pages of documentary materials, over 1,500 photos, and approximately 35 other items of media in compliance with SGF's subpoena duces tecum. The MCPO withheld production of privileged or protected materials.<sup>1</sup>

The MCPO also withheld a number of other items that are not typically produced pursuant to civil subpoena, but indicated to SGF that the Prosecutor's Office would address any specific demands for such items on a case-by-case basis. Subsequently, Mark Silver, Esq., counsel for SGF, has requested production of certain items, specifically, forensic data extractions from three cell phones recovered during the criminal investigation<sup>2</sup> and more specifically identified as: Morris County Sheriff's Office Item Number 1 (Samsung cell phone), Morris County Sheriff's Office Item Number 14 (Apple iPhone), and Morris County Sheriff's Office Item Number 26 (Verizon

Galaxy cell phone).

Given the nature of the aforementioned items, the State respectfully requests that This Court enter an Order directing production of these audio files pursuant to SGF's *subpoena duces tecum* if the items are deemed necessary according to the terms of the *subpoena*.

By copy of this letter, the State gives notice to the civil parties and interested individuals pursuant to the five day rule.
